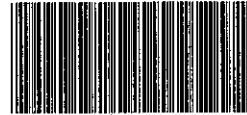


The plaintiff relies on the following facts and assertions:

1. The plaintiff is a company duly incorporated in New South Wales and carries on a business from Level 11, 10 Barrack Street SYDNEY NSW 2000.
2. The defendant is a natural person who reside(s) at [REDACTED].
3. On or about 16 February 2006 the defendant entered into a credit card agreement, agreement number 4564851100920368 ("the contract") with the St George Bank Limited.
4. On 4 May 2010 the defendant owed the St George Bank Limited \$24799.75 under the Contract ('the Debt').
5. On 4 May 2010 the St George Bank Limited assigned to Credit Corp Services Pty Limited its beneficial rights, title and interest to the Debt and its rights against the defendant(s) under the Contract
6. On 10 May 2010 the plaintiff sent to the defendant written notice of the assignment of the Debt.
7. The defendant(s) has wrongfully failed and refused to pay the plaintiff the amount due which is still due and owing to the plaintiff.
8. The plaintiff claims against the defendant(s) interest on the claim from the date of sending the defendant written notice of the assignment of the debt on 10 May 2010 to the date of entry of judgment at the rate of 8.66%.
9. The plaintiff claims against the defendant(s) costs.

The judgment may be for the relief claimed in the statement of claim and for the plaintiff's costs of bringing these proceedings. The court may provide third parties with details of any default judgment entered against you.

**HOW TO RESPOND**

**Please read this statement of claim very carefully. If you have any trouble understanding it or require assistance on how to respond to the claim you should get legal advice as soon as possible.**

You can respond in one of the following ways:

1. **If you intend to dispute the claim**, by filing a defence and/or making a cross-claim
2. **If money is claimed, and you believe you owe the money claimed**, by:
  - Paying the plaintiff all of the money and interest claimed. If you file a notice of payment under UCPR 6.17 further proceedings against you will be stayed unless the court otherwise orders.
  - Filing an acknowledgement of the claim.
  - Applying to the court for further time to pay the claim.
3. **If money is claimed, and you believe you owe part of the money claimed**, by:
  - Paying the plaintiff that part of the money that is claimed.
  - Filing a defence in relation to the part that you do not believe is owed.
